The following Indentures and legal documents are all concerning Berkley Fairthorne, who was the son of Amariah Fairthorne of the Manor House, Shrivenham. Berkley inherited all his father's estate upon his death in 1907. By 1912 he borrowed a lot of money that was all secured on the estate at Shrivenham. Berkley himself lived at Lindfield, near Abingdon and worked as an Engineer in Egypt. In the summer of 1920, a complete survey of the Shrivenham Estate was carried out, and the whole estate was sold at auction on 24th July 1922 at the Goddard Arms Hotel, Swindon.
