James Lewis also settled in Granville Co. about this period. Of his first cousins, John Lewis lived in nearby Halifax Co., Va., and Robert Lewis in Granville Co.

He became one of the most prominent citizens of the county. He served in the North Carolina Legislature in 1785-1786 as Senator from Granville Co.¹ He inherited one-eighth of his father's estate. Howell d. 20 Nov. 1813, Mary Isabella d. 5 Sept. 1813. They had ten children:
