19th century Farms & Cottage rents

It was George, yet another nephew of William the 2nd Viscount, who was to become the 5th Viscount and it was during his reign that we have further information on life at Beckett.

One notable change occurred with regard to the road. The main road to Longcot was very narrow and would be extremely close to the new Mansion House being planned. So, it was decided to re-route it to the course that it is today. The construction of it was carried out through 1817 and 1818, overseen by George Merryweather, the Steward of the Beckett Estate. The photograph below shows the original course.

It was from George's tenure that a large accounts book survives and is now in the archives of the Berkshire Record Office indexed as BRO D/EX52/E1. In the description at the beginning of the book it notes, '*An account of the Rents received by George Merryweather since he came to Beckett in April 1815. Pages 1 to 29, a specification of the Beckett Farms at Michaelmas 1815, grounded on Mr Barnes' valuation in 1811. Also, the Rent Roll, the result of his valuation, subject however, to the incidents and changes posterior to Mr Barnes valuation in 1811.' This gentleman was Steward to the Rev. George Barrington, the 5th Viscount Barrington, who was the Prebendary of Durham Cathedral and Rector of Sedgefield. Being mostly away he left the running of Beckett Estate to Merryweather and paid him £300 per annum for so doing. A large cache of letters written by George Merryweather to his employer, Lord Barrington, were discovered in a Barrington family file at the British Library. These have been transcribed and are now available in a SHS publication called 'The Letters of George Merryweather.' The above list would appear to be an accurate representation of the rental affairs of the Beckett Estate as it came out of a 20year trust period in 1814. The letters of George Merryweather mentioned above, confirm this to be the case.
