Copyhold Enfranchisement

Award of Enfranchisement

Whereas the Lands described in the Schedule hereto are held by Copy of Court Roll of the Manor of Hainwick in the County of Berks and Amariah William Fairthorne of Shruenham in the said County brewer is the Tenant upon the Court Roll of the said Lands

And whereas the Enfranchisement of the said Land has been duly required according to the provisions of "The Copyhold Acts"

And whereas The President and Scholars of the College of Saint Mary Magdalen in the University of Oxford who are the Lords of the said Manor have consented in writing to the Enfranchisement extending to the rights reserved by "The Copyhold Act 1852" Section 48

And whereas the amount to be paid for such Enfranchisement has been ascertained under the provisions of "The Copyhold Acts" to be the sum of Fifteen pounds which has been duly paid and the receipt for the same has been produced to the Board of Agriculture

And whereas all other acts and matters required by the said Acts previously to the confirmation of this Award of Enfranchisement have been duly done and performed

Now the Board of Agriculture in pursuance of the powers vested in them by the Board of Agriculture Act 1889 and "The Copyhold Acts" do by this Award of Enfranchisement enfranchise All the said Copyhold Lands described in the Schedule hereto with their appurtenances including the rights reserved by "The Copyhold Act 1852" Section 48 to be holden as Freehold henceforth and for ever discharged from all fines heriots reliefs quit rents and all other incidents whatsoever of Copyhold or customary tenure but so as not to affect such right of escheat for want of heirs as is reserved by "The Copyhold Act 1887" Section 4

In witness and confirmation whereof the Board of Agriculture have hereunto set their Official Seal this twenty-eighth day of October One thousand eight hundred and ninety three.

The Schedule hereinbefore referred to

All those three Cottages or tenements situate and being in Shruenham in the County of Berks with the gardens and

appurtenances to the same belonging and also
all that Close of meadow or pasture ground
situate and being in Shrivenham containing
together by estimation one acre (more or less) and
adjoining or lying near to the said Cottages or
tenements and gardens (except and reserved to
William Ward and James Haines their heirs and
assigns a right of way or road of the width of ten
feet from the Street in the Village of Shrivenham to
the Cottage/garden and premises belonging to the
said William Ward and James Haines in Shrivenham aforesaid
and from the same Cottage/garden and premises to the said Street
through over and upon the said Close of meadow or pasture ground
with full power and free liberty and license for the said William
Ward and James Haines and each of them their and each of
their heirs and assigns and all other persons whosoever having
occasion to go or pass to or from the said Cottage/garden
and premises or any part thereof and to or from the said
Street and either with or without horses cattle carts and carriages
to go and pass to and fro about and upon the said way
or road at all times at their pleasure) To all which
premises the said Amariah William Fairthorne was
admitted Tenant on the 26th day of March 1863.
