MF 456 28/1 Survey of a manor [unspecified] the 1 doc. c.1650-1660 lord of the manor being described as "the Lord". [Mr. Oliver Pleydell held the glebe, the manor therefore probably being Watchfield or the Rectory Manor, Shrivenham (although the house of Stallpitts manor is mentioned)]. This survey or terrier probably set out the lands before enclosure as each holder of land has a share of meadow and pasture, and land in "Sands land" and "Stoneland" which presumably were common fields rather than geological descriptions.
