This Indenture

made the thirtieth
day of January one
thousand nine hundred and five **Between Sarah**
KNAPP of Shivenham in the County of Becks widow
of the one part and **JOSEPH KNAPP** of Shivenham
aforesaid Gentleman of the other part **WITNESSED** by an
indenture dated the third day of April One thousand
nine hundred and made between Amariah John &
Faithorne of the one part and the said Sarah Knapp
of the other part the plot of land hereinafter described
was with other land and buildings adjoining conveyed
unto ~~to~~ ^{for} the use of the said Sarah Knapp in fee simple
And whereas the said Sarah Knapp erected two
houses on part of the said lands **And whereas** the
said Sarah Knapp has agreed with the said Joseph
Knapp for the sale to him of the plot of land hereinafter
described and on part of which one of the said houses
is built at the price of Three hundred and two pounds
Now this indenture witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of **THREE HUNDRED AND**
TWO POUNDS to the said Sarah Knapp now paid
by the said Joseph Knapp (the receipt whereof the said
Sarah Knapp hereby acknowledges) the said Sarah
Knapp as beneficial owner ^{hereby} conveys unto the
said Joseph Knapp **All that** plot of land situate
at Shivenham in the County of Becks having a frontage
to the main road leading from Shivenham to
Saxington of twenty five feet or thereabouts and
bounded on the north and east side by the National
School and on the west side by other property of the
said Sarah Knapp **TOGETHER** with the messuage
and buildings on part thereof erected and now in the
occupation of Thomas Money which hereditaments
are delineated on the plan drawn herein and thereon
colored pink. **AND ALSO** All that plot of garden
ground situate at Shivenham aforesaid bounded on
the north and south by property belonging to Viscount
Saxington and on the west by property belonging to
the Parish Council of Shivenham and on the east by
other property of the said Sarah Knapp which land
is now occupied with the last mentioned hereditament
and is colored green on the said plan Together with





the full right and liberty for the said Joseph Knapp his heirs and assigns owner or owners for the time being of the land lastly hereinbefore described and his and their tenants and servants and all other persons authorised in that behalf by him or them from time to time at all times hereafter at his and their will and pleasure and for all purposes to pass and repass with or without barrows over and along the way of the width of two feet through the adjoining land which way is delineated on the said plan and thereon colored yellow **To hold** unto and to the use of the said Joseph Knapp in fee simple **And** the said Sarah Knapp hereby acknowledges the right of the said Joseph Knapp to production of the documents of title mentioned in the schedule hereto and to delivery of copies thereof and hereby undertakes for the safe custody thereof **In witness** whereof the said parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first before written
